




# Security!

This is a screengrab of the user interface for HTMLDOC where the security features can be manipulated

A password for the owner as well as a password for the user may be defined.

In this case print is permitted, but copy, annotate and modify are not permitted.



This feature makes this PDF converter a very powerful tool.

Now the ebook can be downloaded by a prospective customer – but the customer/user needs to obtain a password from the owner.

# Using Word

The easiest route to go is to use Word(TM)97 of Microsoft(R) Corporation directly.

When using Word(TM)97 you can directly write an enormous document. First write the document and save as a DOC. After that save the document to HTML by using "File", "Save as HTML". After creating all the HTML pages associated with the ebook – (book) all the separate pages can be integrated by using HTMLDOC. This is a very powerful feature of HTMLDOC and it can be exploited. During this last year I have created ebooks with more than twenty chapters. Each chapter was created separately and then all the chapters were integrated into one single ebook.






This is exciting – Now you can integrate all your web pages and then go ahead to create a PDF version of the book using the integrated pages or create an ebook in EXE format by using the appropriate software.


